

**DIRECTIONS:**

- **FASTBREAK IS A CONCENTRATE AND MUST BE DILUTED WITH WATER TO ACTIVATE SPECIAL CLEANING AGENTS**
- Depending on type of equipment used, vary dilution and contact time where necessary for greater or lesser cleaning.
- **Hot High Pressure:** *Light cleaning:* 1 to 50 parts water *Heavy cleaning:* 1 to 10 parts water
- **General Cleaning** (floors, walls, etc.): 1 to 30 parts water
- **Heavy Grease:** 1 to 5 parts water
- **Sun/Heat:** Use highest dilution ratios when washing in the sun or extremely hot surfaces.

- It is very effective in dissolving hydrocarbon deposits, grease, oil, road film, soil, scum, etc.
